MEASURING

In accordance with AKC regulations, all dogs, with the exception of 24" class dogs, must either present a temporary or permanent height card, or be measured by the judge of record prior to running. If a Voluntary Measuring Official or Rep is present at the trial ALL dogs without a valid height card must be measured. If your dog does not have a jump height card, they will need to be measured prior to running. You should carry your jump height card with you and be able to present the card if requested at the trial It is the handler's responsibility to make sure their dog without a height card is measured prior to the commencement of their first class. Judging will not be held or interrupted for measuring.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers of dogs in Regular Classes may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred Classes MUST jump in their measured division and are not allowed to jump higher or lower.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors under cover on a packed dirt surface. Ring size will be 93' x 100'

Check your entries carefully - Illegible and invalid entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries are invalid if not signed, are incomplete, do not include the current AKC agreement and are received with insufficient funds.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....*Blue*

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

Second Place.....*Red*

Third Place.....*Yellow*

Fourth Place.....*White*

Qualifying Score.....*Dark Green*

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A PAX rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PAX. A MACH and PACH rosette and decorated bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH or PACH.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM **Monday, March 25, 2019** via e-mail. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated for the following day, provided the information is turned in to the Trial Secretary before the trial ends the previous day.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Oconee River Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The **Oconee River Kennel Club** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Oconee River Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason, minus \$5 per run (each day), upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

Injuries – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund of minus \$5 per entered run.

A written veterinarian letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Exhibitors must adhere to the Oconee County Parks and Recreation rules and club requests. No alcoholic beverages allowed on park grounds. There is no smoking allowed at all within the park property. It is a tobacco free facility.

Show grounds must be cleared after the end of trial on Sunday. No one will be allowed to stay on grounds Sunday night.

RV Parking: No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available. Absolutely no dumping of holding tanks on the show grounds. No parking before 12:00 Noon, Friday, prior to the trial. No one will be allowed to stay on grounds Sunday night. RV parking fee: \$15/weekend and must be submitted with RV form.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted within 100 feet of the show site with exception of designated ORKC generators.

No dogs allowed in restrooms.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at motels and/or the park grounds. Any exhibitors who abuse motel property and/or park grounds may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Your responsible conduct at area motels and park site ensures continued community support.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Programs may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
